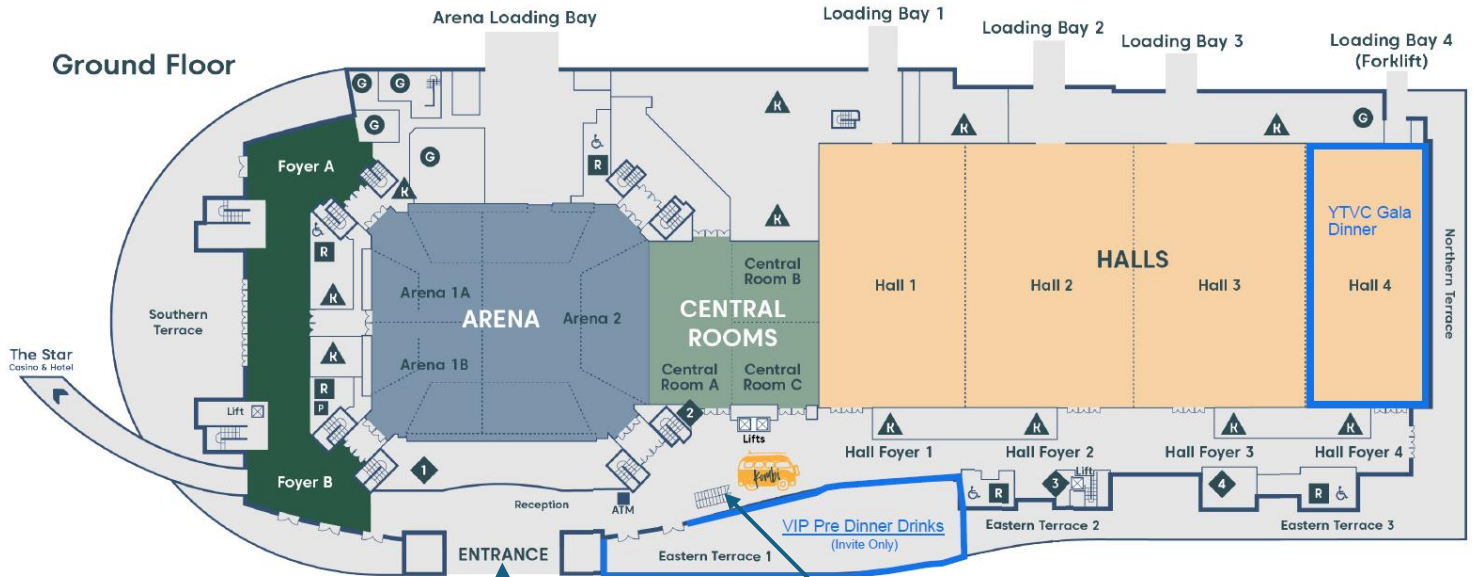
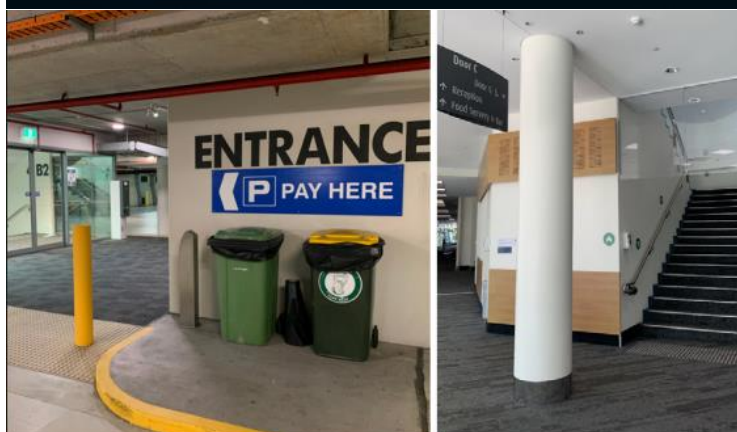

ARRIVING

If you arrive by tram, bus, taxi or ride share, you will enter through the main entrance facing the Gold Coast Highway.



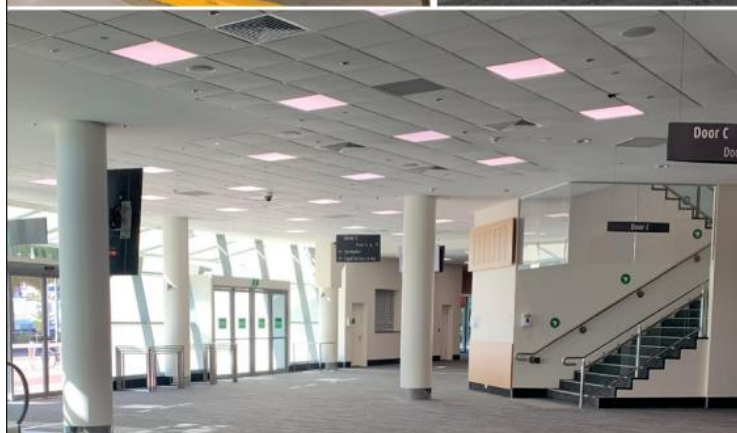

ENTERING FROM THE CAR PARK

Entry to the carpark is on the northern end of the building and can be accessed from the Gold Coast Highway or TE Peters Drive. There are two parking levels B1 and B2. Further details about parking and payment can be found in the Accessibility Guide.

At the central entrance point, you can take the stairs or the lift to the ground floor (G) of the convention centre. Look for signs overhead to the main reception, located between Door C and Door D.

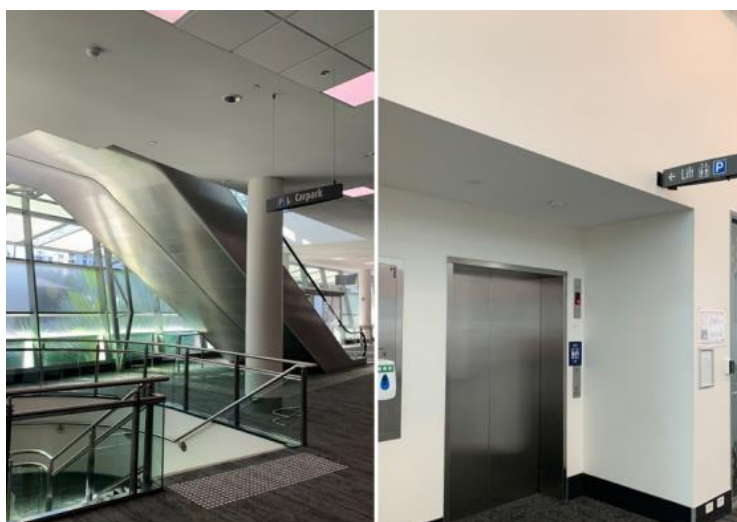

LEAVING

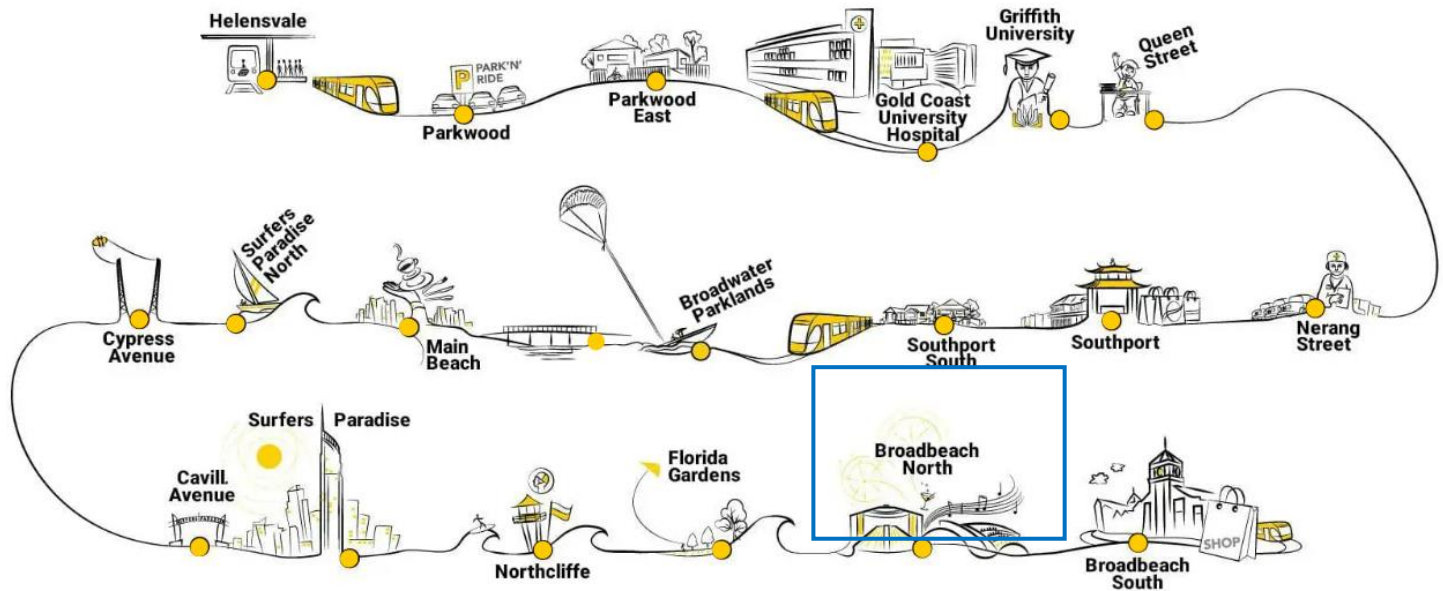
You will follow a similar route leaving as you did arriving at the convention centre. You may exit through the main doors on the ground level.

If you are exiting through the car park, you will see signs at several locations throughout the convention centre to take stairs or lift down to parking levels B1 or B2.

To get to the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre (GCCEC), ride the G:link light rail tram to **Broadbeach North station**, which is located directly outside the venue on the Gold Coast Highway.

Rideshare

Traveling by rideshare from the Q1 Resort in Surfers Paradise to the Gold Coast Convention and Exhibition Centre (GCCEC) in Broadbeach covers about 2.9 km and takes roughly 7 minutes. Fares typically range from \$14 to \$17, and drop-offs occur at the designated zone right at the main entrance.

Trip Details

- **Distance:** 2.9 km
- **Travel time:** 7 minutes (driving)
- **Estimated cost:** \$14 – \$17 (via standard rideshare or taxi)
- **Drop-off location:** Dedicated bays at the main entrance on the Gold Coast Highway [[1](#), [2](#), [3](#)]
